TO FIND	FOUND	FOUND
TO SHOOT	SHOT	SHOT
TO THROW	THREW	THROWN
TO TEACH	TAUGHT	TAUGHT
TO BITE	BIT	BITTEN
TO BUILD	BUILT	BUILT
TO WRITE	WROTE	WRITTEN
TO BEAT	BEAT	BEATEN
TO BURST	BURST	BURST
TO FORGIVE	FORGAVE	FORGIVEN
TO GROW	GREW	GROWN
